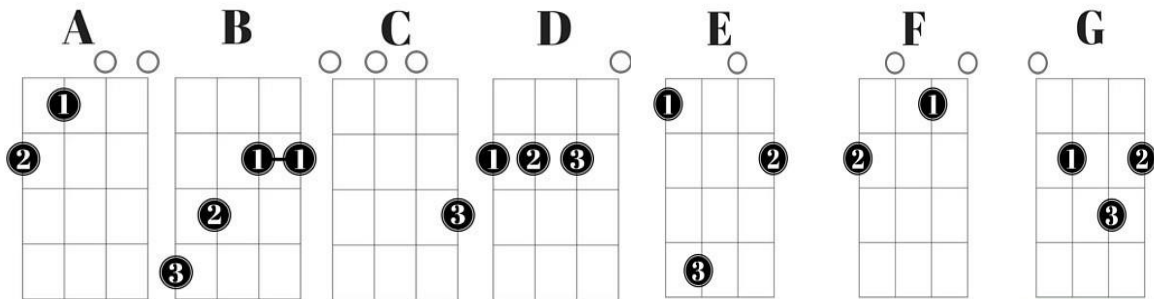

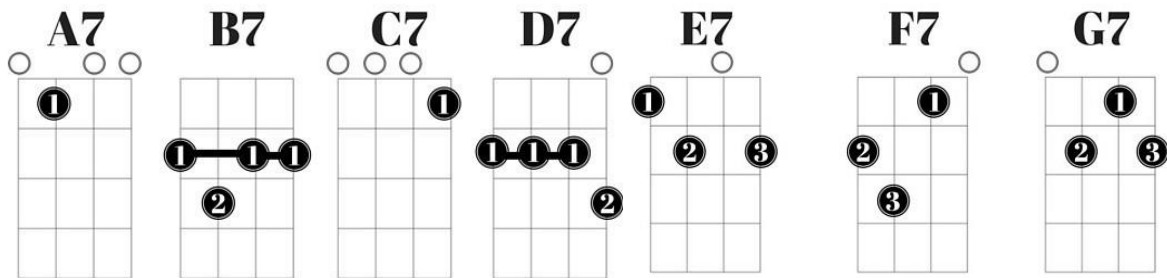

# Chart of (Basic) Chords

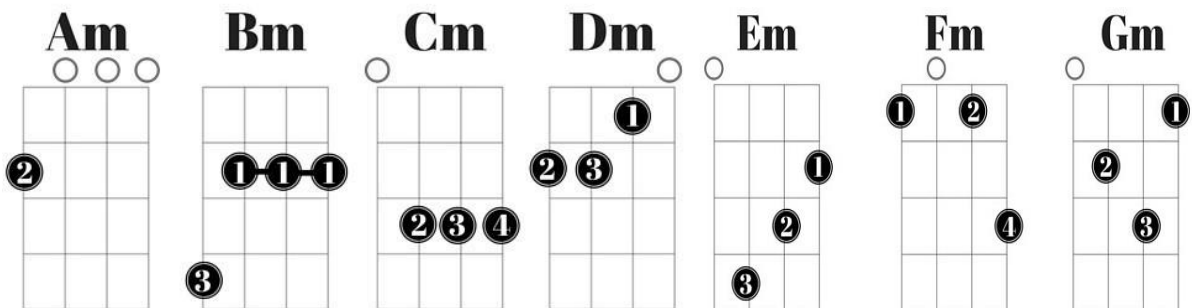

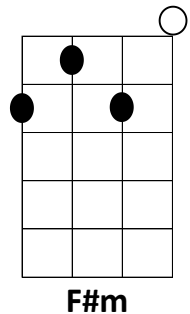

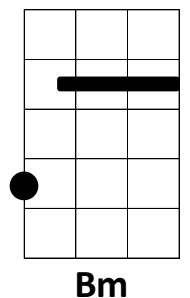
