WARRINGTON BOROUGH COUNCIL ~ £150 ENERGY REBATE

An elderly resident was complaining that she hasn't received the £150 energy rebate from Warrington Borough Council. Old school, she takes herself into town twice a year to pay her Council Tax in person. And therein lies the rub. The rebate is paid automatically into bank accounts if residents (living in accommodation rated Band A-D) pay Council Tax by direct debit. If not, residents must complete a claim form. I've attached info from the WBC website. If you don't pay your Council Tax by direct debit, now you know what to do to get your £150. And in good Longbarn community spirit, you may care to share the contents of this post with your neighbours.



“WBC is currently in the process of issuing the rebate payment of £150 to eligible households in Warrington.

“The rebate, which does not have to be repaid, is available to anyone residing in properties in Council Tax bands A-D. WBC has already automatically paid the £150 to nearly all Warrington households who pay their Council Tax by direct debit.

“However, those who do not pay their Council Tax by direct debit need to complete an application form to claim their rebate.

“If you are eligible for the rebate but have not yet claimed it, you can do so by visiting warrington.gov.uk/rebate, which provides a range of information about the payment.

“The on-line application form is quick & easy to complete. Make sure you apply, so you don't miss out.
