The poppy is an enduring symbol of remembrance of The First World War. It was a common sight on The Western Front, & is strongly linked with Armistice Day. In modern times poppies are now worn as a symbol both of remembrance & out of respect, for those we've loved & lost in worldwide conflict.

Folk may remember that LRA bought a load of super large plastic poppies (18" x 18"). We invited residents & local businesses to sponsor them; decorated each one with the name of the sponsor; & erected them on the lampposts on Harper's Road.

The sponsorship raised £710 ~ an incredible show of generosity & community spirit ~ which we donated to The Royal British Legion. A credit to all concerned.
